Kindly note the following procedures for the admission of your ward:

- Online pre-registration is to be done through our website [www.sisjuwaiza.com](http://www.sisjuwaiza.com) Double-check the details such as DOB, Full name, contact details, Passport details, visa details, etc.
- Possible vacancy of seats will be for grades 1 to 9, against TC.
- You are required to visit the website for more updates.
- There will be an eligibility test for each grade as per the registrations.
- **Deadline for registration: 7:00 p.m. on Monday, 27/01/2025.**
- **Test date: Sunday 09/02/2025** (Details will be communicated soon.)
- The results and further details will be published in the website after the tests.
- Registration fees and the other school fees should be paid upon finalization of admissions.

### **Please note the following:**

- Hindi is compulsory for grades I to VIII. Grade IX students can opt their second language as Hindi, Malayalam or Special Arabic depending on the availability of seats.
- Parents are required to submit a declaration form, along with the copies of the relevant documents for confirmation of admissions.
- You will be requested to produce the original documents at the school office at the time of admission. ([Click here](#) to see the list of documents)
- Submission of original TC with the mark list of the final examination is mandatory for the registration of your ward with the Sharjah Private Education Authority.
- Valid visa is a mandatory requirement for admissions.
- Online Registration doesn't guarantee admission.
