Grade II- X & XII (2026-2027) (Including new admissions)	Monday, 30 th March 2026
Grade XI (2026-2027)	Tuesday, 31 st March 2026
Grade I (2026-2027) (Including new admissions)	Wednesday, 1 st April 2026

As we prepare for the upcoming school year, please take note of the following important updates:

- **Learning Mode:** Classes will initially begin **online**. We will transition to face-to-face sessions as soon as approval is granted by the Sharjah Private Education Authority (SPEA).
- **Communication & Access:** Section-wise WhatsApp groups will be used to share Zoom links. Please ensure all outstanding fees from the previous year are cleared, as students with pending dues will not be added to the new groups. Once cleared, please notify the previous class teacher to update the records.
- **Grade 1 Boys (Juwaiza Campus):** Please be advised that bus routes available in Ghubaiba may not extend to the Juwaiza campus. Parents must confirm bus pick-up points with the transport department before making payments.
- **Digital Resources:** Google Classrooms will be set up shortly. Until book-kits are distributed, students may use their old notebooks for temporary notes.
- **New Admissions:** If a newly admitted student has not been added to a group by **Saturday, March 28, 2026**, please email their details to **mail@sisjuwaiza.com**.
- **Provisional Admissions:** Students with provisional status will be added to classes temporarily. Final admission is subject to the completion of assessments and fee payments.
